

# Toronto Sake Challenge 2025 Application Rules

TOPIC	POINT
Eligibility Criteria	All producers, distributors, exporters, consultants and importers of sake.
Types of Sake	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Sake made by all methods and types (Honjozo, Junmai, Ginjo, Junmai Ginjo, Daiginjo, Junmai Daiginjo, Koshu, Craft sake and etc.).</li> </ul>
Sizes of Sake	<p>Standard 2 x 720ml bottles for each entry.            -A total amount of 1440ml entered as minimum.  <u>-But each bottle must have a capacity of 1L or less.</u>            * This does not apply if the participant arranges transport to a given destination in Toronto.</p>
How to Enter	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Via official website</li> </ul> <p>*Alternatively, please use the Registration Form</p>
Entry Fee	<p>550 CA\$ per entry</p> <p>*Customs duties and related costs after arrival in Toronto will be covered by the local organiser, if applicable.</p>

TOPIC	POINT
How to Pay	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Credit card</li> <li>Paypal</li> <li>Bank transfer (including international remittance services such as Wise)</li> </ul> <p>* Entrants are responsible for all service charges that occur during the payment process.</p>
Bank Details	This will be indicated on the invoice sent after the reception is completed.
Entry Deadline	<b>23rd July 2025</b>
Delivery Deadline	<b>30th July 2025</b> <b>*The sake must arrive at the designated address by this date.</b>

## Step1

- Entry via official website or by sending the registration form (from website)
- Important Note: As a general rule, we will use the exact description entered here so please ensure there are no errors.

## Step2

- After completion of the application, an acceptance email with information on the delivery of the exhibited alcohol will be sent to the applicant. Please make sure to check it.
- \*In the unlikely event that you do not receive the email, please inform us at the contact address.

## Step3

There are three additional procedures depending on the submitted exhibited liquor .

- If the sake can be purchased locally.
  - If the sake can be purchased from a retailer in Canada.
  - If the product is not available for purchase in Canada.

## Step4

- We will handle your sample bottles carefully.
- Please wait until the results are announced.
